

FOLD 2.0 | ABC Emporio

The many faceted design of the façade emphasizes the expertise of the designers, known for creating projects that stand out and grab attention.

OVERVIEW


Made conspicuous as much by its design as its location, ABC Emporio is another one of the stand out projects by the architects, now recognized for their unusual, path-breaking designs. Sitting in the midst of a conventional, busy neighborhood, Emporio is flanked by the usual shops and


showrooms one comes across in everyday wanderings in everyday streets. This makes the impact of the showroom even more pronounced. The project inserts itself on a high footprint street, integrating itself into the city through scale and proportions. Contrasting against its immediate surroundings is the geometric exterior. This geometrical art form that arises from the shape of site and its multifactored retail surroundings folds to form a crystalline structure and unfolds to an unusual outdoor space which allows the user to connect to the surroundings. A white aluminum skin pleats in and out, resulting in a sculptural effect imparted to the facade. Small circular perforations ranging from dense to sparse collections admit natural light into the interior in a controlled fashion. The geometry opens up to form an indoor-outdoor terrace space opening itself to the vistas of the city. The interiors too follow the language of the façade, weaving in irregular, yet easy to maneuver circulation spaces and product displays.






Nighttime illumination has been done in a way that it highlights the different facets of the façade.

Branching upwards and supporting the roof is the column resembling the anatomy of a tree, complete with branches and foliage.









Exclusive light fixtures and intelligent ambient lighting allows the project to come alive, especially during night-time.

The counter displaying faucets is designed in way that it seems like an impossible cantilever, floating over the surface of the floor.




Clean, white and minimal display stations for water cabinets and bath tubs bring the products on display to focus.

Tiles and stones have been displayed over a black background, so they might get highlighted and come to focus.





Different display areas help the clients to imagine how the products would look on site, helping them make an informed decision.
